# **RECIPROCAL GOLF BETWEEN CLUBS**

The Windmill Golf Group offers a unique multi-club membership model that includes a Home Club, plus access, privileges, reciprocal golf and special rates to play local Sister Clubs.

### **PLAYING WINDOWS:**

Mon-Friday anytime, excluding holidays. Sat, Sun & holidays after 2 pm.

# **HOW IT WORKS**

#### RECIPROCAL BALLOT SYSTEM

- A weekly online ballot system conducted through a central Windmill Concierge.
- All clubs dedicate 16 reciprocal times per day to hold for Sister Club members.
- A Member may submit a ballot each week from their Home Club website for the times and club(s) they wish to play in the week ahead.
- Ballots to be submitted by 6:00 pm on Wednesday for the following Monday through Sunday.
- The ballot times will be fairly rotated by the Concierge. If a Member does not receive a ballot tee time, he/she will be placed on a priority list if submitting a ballot request for the following week.

### 3-DAY BOOKINGS, VIA THE HOST CLUB

- Reciprocal times will be accepted at each club with a 3-day advance booking up until there are 16 remaining tee times.
- When 16 or less open tee times remain on a tee sheet, reciprocal times are no longer available for that day. The last 16 times are reserved for member play or to generate revenue through guests or green fee play to help each club operate.
- Please contact the host club directly to confirm availability and if more than 16 times remain, a reciprocal reservation can be made starting at 6:00 pm, 3 days prior.

### 6-8 DAY BOOKINGS, WITH WINDMILL RATES

- Members receive a reduced rate to play Sister Clubs if they choose to book ahead of the 3-day window or do not submit or receive a ballot time.
- 6-8 day advance booking (6 days at BP & HGC / 8 days at MN, HP & SBK).
- Bookings may be made direct to the Club you wish to play or through your Home Club.

#### **FURTHER DISCOUNT WITH GUEST PLAY**

We appreciate Members bringing business within our Windmill family. We also prefer a member representative in each group to help with course etiquette and pace of play as we actively grow membership at each Club. Windmill Members receive 25% off regular rates in the 6-8 day booking window and discounted further when bringing 1-2, or 3 guests, as follows:

## **UPON CHECK IN AT A SISTER CLUB:**

Staff will confirm the date you booked, or were booked for, and charge to member account as follows:

- 1. If booked via the ballot, no charge for the reciprocal green fee.
- 2. If booked 3 days or less, no charge for the reciprocal green fee.
- 3. If booked 6-8 days or less, the above Windmill Rates apply.
- 4. The day the original booking was made and the number of guests you arrive with determine your Windmill Rate.

## **NOTES & DEFINITIONS**

**Adjustments:** As per the Membership Plan, adjustments may be made from time to time to modify the terms of access to the Additional Golf Amenities (Sister Clubs), in the best interest of the Clubs.

**Access:** The ability to book a private or semi-private Sister or Destination Club.

**Bookings:** A variety of ways to book and play the Sister Clubs via:

- i) A weekly ballot system through a link on the Home Club website; or
- ii) 3-day advance booking through your Home Club. Bookings are accepted up until 16 tee times remain on a tee sheet. The balance are then reserved for public green fee play.
- iii) 6-8 day advance booking with reduced Windmill Rates direct to the club you wish to play or via your Home Club. Deeper discounts apply with guest play.

Carts: Annual cart dues purchased at a Home Club does not carry to a Sister Club. Regular cart rates apply.

**Concierge Service:** An online ballot system to request tee times to play Sister Clubs. The Concierge shall assign, track, monitor and rotate tee times fairly between members and clubs.

**Destination Clubs:** Courses not owned or managed by Windmill, but whom Windmill has built relationships to offer special rates when traveling across Canada, the U.S. and abroad.

**Home Club:** The club chosen to be your Home Club via agreement with the club's Membership Plan. A Member's Home Club is where a Member shall play the majority of his/her golf and where the Member shall play club events, such as; men's night, ladies' night, couple's night and club tournaments (Club Championship, Ryder Cup, etc.). The Home Club is also where a Member shall use the driving range and practice facilities. Sister Club ranges may be used for warm-up when associated with a round of golf.

**Membership Plan:** Each club has its own Membership Plan with terms and conditions precedent to a Home Club Member.

Pass Holder Passes: For Members who selected the Pass Holder dues option, the following applies:

- Passes are accepted at Home Clubs for Members and guests.
- Passes are accepted at Sister Clubs for Primary Members only, under the same booking procedures as in this document.
- Passes are not accepted for guest play at Sister Clubs.
- Pass Holder guests receive the Member-Guest rate at the Sister Club being played.

Playing Windows: Days / times when play at Sister Clubs is available for Members and guests, being:

- · Mon-Friday anytime, excluding holidays; and
- · Sat, Sun & holidays after 2 pm.

**Reciprocal Golf:** No-charge green fees at a Sister Club when booked through balloting or a 3-day advance booking. When a club is closed in the shoulder season or for renovation, their reciprocal privileges may be adjusted.

#### Rates:

- Family Rates: Reciprocal golf carries to spouse and intermediate family members who purchased an annual due at their Home Club.
- Windmill Rates: Special rates for Members who do not submit or receive a ballot time or a reciprocal time within the 3-day window.
- Juniors receive the junior rate and same junior playing window(s) of the Sister Club being played.

**Sister Clubs:** Local golf clubs managed by Windmill who offer reciprocal golf and privileges to other Windmill members.
